

1. The Board of Selectmen reviewed the Citizen's Petition for Procedures Regarding Acceptance of Non-York Land Development Impacting Municipal Services and the Town Attorney's written opinion of the petition. It was decided not to put the Citizen's Petition forward to the voters
2. The Board of Selectmen decided to retain the property located at Lake Carolyn Tax Map 9 Lot 20 pending further information regarding the cost of maintaining the property and repair of the damn located on the property.
3. The Board of Selectmen voted to schedule a public hearing on May 12th, 2008 concerning the sale of Town-Owned Property at 21 Axholme Road
4. The Board of Selectmen decided to accept the revisions, changes and added information to the Town of York Senior Center and the York Senior Center Inc, Mission Statement and By-Laws.
5. The Board of Selectmen discussed the Maine Turnpike Authority's Toll Booth Relocation Project with the group *Think Again* and decided to strongly endorse a Resolution which clearly states their opposition to the relocation of the York Toll Plaza to another site In the Town of York.
6. The Board of Selectmen voted to schedule a public hearing on May 12th, 2008 to discuss the possible donation of Town-Owned Property located at 8 Hemlock Avenue to Habitat for Humanity.
7. The Board of Selectmen decided to accept a license agreement with the York Golf and Tennis Club that would grant the York Golf and Tennis Club the right to cross under Organug Road for the purpose of installing an eight inch chase way containing electrical conduit, telephone, and cable conduit from an existing utility pole to the York Golf and Tennis Club property.
8. The Board of Selectmen approved the typographical changes to the FY 2009 Budget Referendum Warrant
9. The Board of Selectmen voted to authorize the reduction of the performance guarantee held for the Atlantic House from \$90,362.50 to \$3,750 because sufficient work has been completed, inspected, and found satisfactory to warrant all but the remaining \$3,750 to be releases
