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Report on Surfing Ordinance

Mike Sullivan, Director of Parks and Recreation, reported that there has been no real significant change in the safety conditions for surfers and swimmers due to the Surfing Ordinance. The surfing areas were expanded only four times last year for less than a total of eight hours. The Selectmen suggested that we continue with this ordinance for this summer to see how things go. The Selectmen requested that Mr. Sullivan come back in the fall to report on the conditions of this summer, 2008.
