

Selectmen's Meeting Results

April 28th, 2008

1. Route 103 Parking Lot-The Board of Selectmen decided to approve Route 103 Parking Lot option one that was presented by Dean Lessard, Director of Public Works. Option one of this project entails a parallel parking system that will allow people to walk safely to the crosswalk on an inside path with a curb that will separate the parking area from the path. The parking area will be striped to allow eleven parking spaces.

2. Municipal Solid Waste Contract- The Board of Selectmen moved to authorize the Town Manager to sign the Municipal Solid Waste and Recyclable agreement with Waste Management of New Hampshire.

3. York Beach Zoning-The Planning Board and the Planning Department are looking for motivated members of the community that would like to serve on a subcommittee that will be looking at zoning ordinances for the York Beach Area. The Board of Selectmen agreed that it will be favorable to have a large joint meeting with all parties involved in the York Beach Re-Zoning Project and to get some consensus on what is the best direction to take. This meeting will be scheduled for late May early June.

4. Boundary Discrepancy with Town of Ogunquit-Rick Mace, Town Assessor explained that there have been some boundary discrepancies discovered with the Town of Ogunquit. Mr. Mace suggested that the Board of Selectmen meet with the Town of Ogunquit to look at these discrepancies and determine where the Town boundaries are. The Selectmen asked that Mr. Mace and Mr. Yandow meet and come back to the Board with more specific recommendation on what to do.

5. Memorandum of Understanding with Town of Kittery-The Board of Selectmen asked that the language in the MOU be revised to state that Kittery will be the first responders to the Kittery subdivision of Woodside Meadow. The new language will be sent to the Town Attorney for approval and will then be brought back to the Selectmen on May 12th.

6. Letter of Support for Old York Historical Society Regarding Working Waterfront Access Pilot Project-The Board of Selectmen gave their approval for the Town Manager to draft a letter of support on the behalf of the Board for the Old York Historical Society's proposal to the Working Waterfront Access Pilot Project.

7. EPA Smart Growth Assistance Grant Application- The Board of Selectmen moved to support Cathy Goodwin in writing this grant and authorized Mr. Yandow to write a letter of support for this project.

8. Approval of St. Aspinquid Lodge No.198 request for Flea Market operation approval-The Board of Selectmen approved the operation request for the St. Aspinquid Lodge No.198 Flea Market on Saturdays from May through September of 2008.

9. Meeting with Maine Turnpike Board of Directors-The Board of Selectmen are meeting with the Maine Turnpike Board of Directors on Tuesday, April 29th at 10:00 AM at the Maine Turnpike Headquarters in Portland to discuss the Toll Booth Relocation Project

10. Business Directional Sign for Bittersweet Bed and Breakfast-The Board of Selectmen approved two business directional signs at the corner of Route 1 and Route 1A Northbound and Route 1 and Route 1A Southbound.

11. Business Directional Sign for Mainiax Café- The Board of Selectmen approved two of the three business directional signs requested. The two sign locations are at the discretion of the business.

12. Approval of Parade Permit Application for York Little League-The Board of Selectmen approved the Parade Permit Application for the York Little League which will hold its event on Saturday, May 3rd 2008 from 2:15 PM to 2:45 PM.
