

POLICY PERTAINING TO NOMINATION OF
HISTORIC LANDMARKS & DISTRICTS
REFERENCE PLACING ON GENERAL REFERENDUM
OR SPECIAL GENERAL REFERENDUM

It is the policy of the Town of York to place any nomination of Historic Landmarks and Districts where the property owner is opposed to the nomination on the Warrant for the General Referendum. In cases where the property owner(s) are not opposed to the nomination, the nomination is to be placed before the voters at the next available General or Special General Referendum.
