

**York Maine Committee for Veterans Affairs**  
**Meeting Minutes**  
**6pm, Tuesday July 22,, 2025**  
**York Town Hall**

**Members present:** Don LeFante, Wade Fox, Alan Potvin, Tom Spenser, John Milburn, YPD LT. Scott Study. Altrusa members Judith Goldstein and Linda Gately. Members absent, Lew DiTommaso, Jimmy Carabello, Roger Noel.

**1. Call To order.** Chair Don LeFante called the meeting to order at **6:01pm**. A quorum was determined with 5 members voting.

**2. Minutes from June 17, 2025**, meeting reviewed. Don motioned to approve the minutes with Wade seconding. Minutes approved 5-0.

**3. Chairmans Report; Don LeFante.**

- a. Due to Don's decision to step down as Chairman and to assume the vacant Treasurers position, the CVA moved to fill the Chairman position.
- b. After discussion and a review of interest, Tom Spenser was elected unanimously as the new Chairman. Tom will fill the seat until the next normal election cycle.

**6. York Public Library, Alan Potvin.**

- a. Updated the current library display and its revolving nature.
- b. There's a new effort by YPL to expand youth programs.

**7. Honor Flight, Maine, Alan Potvin.**

- a. Both New England and Maine versions were presented. There are extensive waiting times due to their popularity.
- b. Tom gave a personal account of a visit as he served as a formal host/escort on one of the DC events.
