

SENIOR CITIZENS ADVISORY BOARD MINUTES OF THE MEETING ON SEPTEMBER 16, 2025

MEETING CALLED TO ORDER: 09:02 HOURS

ATTENDANCE: Chair Meyers advised that board member D. McQuade had authorized leave for today's meeting. Carollyn Anderson was absent; attempt was made to contact no answer. All other members were present quorum was met, attendance taken.

OLD BUSINESS: Chair Meyers advised that she had spoken with her contact at the High School. Noting that today is just two weeks into the new school year, he would get back to her with follow-up information when he gets it. Greg Fyfe mentioned that other groups i.e., the Boy Scouts. It was brought to our attention that due to low enrollment, several groups of scouts have had to join into larger towns that still have their programs. Chair will await contact back from HS and will also follow up with YCSA.

Greg Fyfe gave us update on recent drawings from the Architect on the VES Building Committee. It was mentioned VES was a well-constructed building, where walls were removable and allowed for a more open concept. The current lunch area is much larger than CAL more than doubling the amount of lunch space CAL currently has. The school department is supposed to vote on October 15, 2025 re: consolidation into Coastal Ridge. They would also be reviewing effects in the Middle and High School. HS 5% vs 59%. Grade 6 and up have a separate café and gym. Currently two heating systems – boilers approx. exp. 5 mil. Next meeting is September 28 for Committee and then on October 16, 2025.

Discussion re: Adult Day Care, Currently, most nursing homes in the area offer adult daycare services at their location. Also mentioned in Rye NH the Julia House offers adult daycare.

NEW BUSINESS: In following up with the Boston Post Cane it was determined that the York Illustrated had dropped our advertising for this in the Spring issue only. D. Meyers spoke with Peter Murray and he will follow-up to ensure it is posted in both issues. Chair mentioned that we **MUST** obtain a nomination from the public in order to be considered for this honor. There is a lot of follow-ups that is a portion of what the board completes. The nominee is honored by a reception allowing for family members to attend. The Town Manager along with members of the Selectboard are also present and actually presents the award to the honoree.
