Town Manager's Report - 05/08/23

Short Sands / Green Enterprise Recreation Overlay District Project Update

The Planning Board has recommended Town Planning and Urban Design Collaborative (TPUDC) out of Franklin, TN, as the consulting firm to lead the Short Sands / Green Enterprise Recreation Overlay District (GEROD) project. Staff is currently working with TPUDC's management to produce a draft contract for review and approval by the Selectboard at an upcoming meeting. Some of TPUDC's experience in Northern New England includes comprehensive plans in Scarborough, Lewiston, and Manchester NH, as well as Downton Master Plans in Portsmouth NH, and Middlebury VT.

USS North Dakota has arrived at Portsmouth Naval Shipyard

Town Staff would like to formally welcome the USS North Dakota (SSN 784) to port at the Portsmouth Naval Shipyard. The North Dakota made port on Friday 04/28/23.
