The Committee welcomed Brendan to York as the Town Planner. He will be working with Dylan Smith and Taylor Maguire on many issues related to safety and accessibility for cyclists and pedestrians.

The discussions provided Brendan background on bicycle and pedestrian committee initiatives, events, and works in progress.

Crosswalks and upcoming paving and capital improvement projects were discussed. Scott will talk to Taylor Maguire about designs for the next section of the Sidewalk/seawall project with a focus on sightlines for pedestrians and motorists at crosswalks. He will also check with Tim Diperrio about plans for shoulders, sidewalks, and crossings on FY-25 paving projects on Organug and Lindsay roads.
