

**York Conservation Commission – April 2022 Meeting
4/13/2022**

Lake Carolyn and Phillips Pond – Abutters were invited (by the town) to join this meeting via Zoom. The invitation included an agenda with suggested recommendations, seeking feedback and support from abutters and others in the vicinity. DeCarlo Brown, town Land Use Planner, participated. Problems identified included: dumping of trash, grass clippings, and other objects in and around the lake/pond; parking on private roads for access; night-time campfires; noise. Possible ways to address these problems included: signage (emphasizing conservation), barriers to limit parking, fencing in appropriate places. A followup meeting will take place on May 4, to allow identification of specific problem spots around both bodies. Recommendations to the Select Board will then be developed.
