

**Cliff Walk Committee

Minutes

The Committee inspected the Walk in company with representatives of the Parks and Recreation Department. Public participation was also included.

Committee members included: Bob Gordon, Bob Luttmann, Diane Kleist and Tom Rose

Also Included were: Selectman Robert Palmer, Mike Sullivan (Director Parks and Recreation) , Robin Cooger (Incoming Director of Parks and Recreation) and Robin Kerr (Conservation Coordinator – Parks and Recreation) and several members of the Friends of the Cliff Walk.

The group observed both the recent improvements that provide additional safety for walkers as well as the significant damage from the late Winter storms. Storm damage was seen along the entire route including at least two washouts (See attached photos). We were able to reach the Pumping Station next to the Peterson property and to return to Harbor Beach. The newly constructed Pumping Station appeared to be complete and the fences have been removed on both sides of the station with a clear view all the way to Milberry Lane.

Mike Sullivan reported that the FEMA report has not yet been submitted, but the Town is optimistic that Federal Funds will be made available to repair the damage.
