2. Call To Order 6:01pm. Tom motioned to begin the meeting. A quorum of 7 members was established.
3. Minutes of 9/23/2025 meeting reviewed. Tom motioned to approve the minutes. Don seconded. Motion approved 7-0.
4. Veterans Day (Week) Update, Tom Spencer. Norma's is all set with final details.
