Agency presentation and review:

Southern Maine Agency on Aging: requested funding for FY 23 is \$12,500. 525 York Residents served this year. Value of service delivered was \$76,281. Service being requested for funding was meals on wheels. Cost of each meal is \$8.50

Strong Girls United Foundation: first request for funding from this non profit corporation established in August, 2019 was \$15,000. Lani Silverstein is the originator of the program and serves as it Executive Director. SG United Foundation primary mission is to empower and inspire girls through physical activity, sports and mental skills training. COVID had a significant impact on conducting all activities in person. Program partners with York Parks and Recreation to offer after school programs for elementary and middle school children.

Maine Health at Home : request for funding for FY 23 was \$3000. This program provides a number of in home services to York Residents. 35 York residents received in home care at a value of \$66,032. Uncompensated care for York residents was \$3804. Of the 35 residents 20 received home health care while 15 received community health care.
