This map was created using information referred to as Land Use/ Land Cover (LULC). The data was provided by different agencies in the US Department of the Interior, NASA, NOAA, and EPA as shown by their seals at the bottom of this map. This product is referred to as Multi-Resolution Land Characteristics 2001 or MRLC2001, which is terrain corrected Satellite imagery. LULC data is the industry standard for Land Use definitions. The data contains different imagery from 2001 to current day. The data shown here is current as of November 2003. It is acknowledge that the resolution of data does not accommodate for small parcel areas and should be considered a snap-shot of the land use for an area the size of York.
